Youth Art Month Exhibit Guidelines

Each teacher may present **five pieces** of art per school. Students' art will be displayed March 12 - April 9, 2009 in the main galleries of the Carnegie Visual Arts Center. A reception for students exhibiting in YAM, and their families, teachers, and friends, will be March 12th, 4:00 - 7:00 PM. Invitations will be available on March 5th for you to give to your exhibiting students.

1. All teachers must come to the Carnegie Visual Arts Center and frame their students' works on **Thursday, March 5, 2009** from 3:30 PM until 6:00 PM. Frames with glass and backing board will be furnished by the Carnegie. Teachers must furnish **black** tag board, mat board, or poster board on which to mount the piece of art. Please do not pre-cut the mounting board until you have selected a frame because the frames are various sizes. Only one piece of art per frame. We are looking for the **best** art from the works of your students.
2. The majority of our frames are 11" x 14" for approximately 9" x 12" sized art. The size of two-dimensional artwork shall not exceed 20" x 28". Please refer to the frame list when selecting the works to submit.
3. No photocopied, duplicated, or traced works will be allowed for exhibition; only original pieces of artwork.
4. No group works and no art containing organic materials, such as food products.
5. Artwork should not be covered in acetate, shrink-wrap or plastic wrap. If protection of the piece is needed for transport, please cover with a removable paper overlay.
6. All entries must have a completed YAM entry form which will be attached to the back of the artwork after it is framed. In order to ensure proper recognition and return of the piece after the show, this information is extremely important.
7. Three-dimensional work should be small enough to fit on a 2' x 2' pedestal, or may be hung on the wall. (If submitting a 3-D piece to be hung, contact the Carnegie for specific instructions.)
8. All artwork must be submitted by an art teacher in Morgan County. Although this is not a juried art show, the Carnegie Visual Arts Center reserves the right to reject any artwork deemed inappropriate. Please do not promise your students that their work will be on display until it is approved on Thursday, March 5, 2009.
9. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in a piece **not** being exhibited.

YAM artwork will be accepted here at the Carnegie on Thursday, March 5, 2009 from 3:30 - 6:00 PM, or by previously arranged appointment. **No entries will be accepted after this time.** Artwork may be picked up after the exhibit on April 14 and 15 (Wednesday and Thursday) from 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM each day.
